



# Title: Resurrection

## John 20:1-9

Early on Sunday morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene went to the tomb and saw that the stone had been taken away from the entrance. She went running to Simon Peter and the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and told them, "They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don't know where they have put him!"

Then Peter and the other disciple went to the tomb. The two of them were running, but the other disciple ran faster than Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent over and saw the linen cloths, but he did not go in. Behind him came Simon Peter, and he went straight into the tomb. He saw the linen cloths lying there and the cloth which had been around Jesus' head. It was not lying with the linen cloths but was rolled up by itself. Then the other disciple, who had reached the tomb first, also went in; he saw and believed. (They still did not understand the scripture which said that he must rise from death.)

**Reflect:** He is risen! Alleluia! Alleluia! We have celebrated the most wonderful feast in our whole year - Easter is the reason our faith exists. Easter is, for Christians, the central and most joyful focus of our faith. Christ, after the most brutal torture and death rose from the dead. He came to life so that you and I could live in the joyful knowledge that all he taught us was truth. This season of Easter is such a joyful time - the preparation time of Lent is over, now we can throw ourselves into the joy. Easter isn't just one day, it's a whole season; a period of 50 days in which to celebrate all that is new and refreshed. We rejoice that Jesus rose from the dead to bring new life to each of us and we are grateful for all the new life that is evident around us. The new life that Jesus died to bring us lies in our hands - we were created in love by God to live our lives joyfully and in love. It is a time when we are challenged to show others through the way we treat them that we are Christians, "alive with the love of God".

- How did this Easter give you joy?
- How do you show that you are alive with the love of God?

Lord, we are seeing signs of new life all around us. The nights are getting lighter, the days brighter, bringing us spring flowers, budding trees and new born lambs. These signs remind us of the new life that you gave to us, the hope that your resurrection brings. Thank you Lord. Amen

Dear Lord,


We are the seed of Notre Dame and we can grow together as a family if we love our neighbours the way God taught us to.
